REGISTRATION AND ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

All day girls are expected to be in school by 08.20, at the latest, in order to register with their tutors every morning. This applies even if your daughter has a study period for her first lesson. **We also expect day girls to remain at school until 15.30**, even if their lessons finish earlier than that on a given day. This is so that girls can take advantage of the excellent study facilities, such as the library. We expect girls with study periods to be working quietly in their studies, the JPR or in the library.
