Entries in the Honours Book are made for outstanding achievement, with girls being put forward by their teachers. Mrs King, Headmistress, sees each one of the girls to discuss her achievement with her and to congratulate her. The girls listed below have recently had their names added to the Honours Book. Congratulations!

Nominated by Mrs Heron, Head of German and English teacher:

Elizabeth Vacher (Upper Five) for excellent work in German throughout this term. *“She participates well beyond what one would expect and has produced work of a consistently outstanding standard.”*

Barbara Roberts (Six One) for active involvement in all German lessons. *“She sets an excellent example to others. Barbara has a scholarly approach to absorbing new vocabulary and she really attempts to incorporate them in her active vocabulary. She reads around the subject and is an outstanding student.”*
