## PE DEPARTMENT - BRIGHTON MARATHON: 18 APRIL 2010

Two members of staff from our PE Department, Mrs Jane Chandler and Mrs Jane Carnaghan, will be running in the city's first ever 26.2 mile Marathon on 18 April. They started their training in early November 2009 and have been committed each week to following a planned programme. This Sunday coming they will be running 20 miles as their final long distance preparation run.

They are running for charity – **Cecily's Fund** – to which proceeds from *Roedean's Got Talent* were donated. Cecily Eastwood was a sparkly 19 year old when she left home to spend a year teaching in Zambia before going to university. She worked as a volunteer with orphaned and vulnerable children in Kitwe in Zambia's Copperbelt province. In June 1997, shortly before she planned to return to England, she was killed in a road accident. Her parents set up Cecily's Fund in her memory and to support the children she worked with.
